To whom it may concern:

The International Council on Systems Engineering (INCOSE) hosts several conferences each year. The International Workshop is a 4-day event with an additional invitation-only day. The International Symposium is a 6-day event with an additional invitation-only day. Regional conferences range from a single day to three days.

Attendance is not typically taken at individual conference activities. Participation is assumed based on in-person check-in at the conference, as demonstrated by acquiring a name badge.

Systems Engineering Professionals (SEPs) who attend these conferences may earn 8 Professional Development Units (PDUs) per day. These PDUs are a required part of maintaining ASEP and CSEP certifications. "Technical Society Participation / Attend Professional Technical Society Conference / Symposium" allows 1 PDU per hour of effort, up to a maximum of 72 hours per renewal period. The renewal period is 5 years for ASEPs and 3 years for CSEPs.
